Mandate and current activities:

The KCMC provides male singers the opportunity to develop vocal skills and musical literacy, in a non-judgemental and friendly atmosphere, while preparing a diverse range of choral repertoire for performance. Rehearsals focus on strengthening vocal production, part singing and ear training skills, as well as mastering a steady stream of challenging repertoire created to exploit the unique characteristics of an all-male chorus.

The choir performs one major concert per season, often with a musical guest whose specialty will provide both an educative opportunity for the choristers and a rewarding concert experience for the audience. The choir also performs small benefit concerts for local charities and clubs/organizations. KCMC has performed benefit concerts for Hospice Kingston, Cooke's – Portsmouth United Church, The University Women's Club, Sydenham United Church in Sydenham, Ontario and as part of its community outreach program has performed in Rideaucrest, St. Lawrence Place and Briargate retirement homes.

Now in its sixth season the KCMC performs a wide range of musical repertoire with expression, accuracy, and a good ensemble sound with a strong sense of joy in singing together.
